What are cookies?

As much as we'd like to offer you delicious baked goods as you explore the We are Vista site, this time we're talking about small pieces of information we store on your computer or mobile device as you browse.

These tiny files help us remember who you are, what you like and how you use our website. They make your future visits easier and more useful, allowing us to recognise you and welcome you with a tailored experience.

The two main kinds of cookie are 'persistent' cookies and 'session' cookies. Session cookies are deleted from your device as soon as you close the browser, while the persistent type are stored until deletion or expiry.

How does We are Vista use cookies?

As you browse our website, we might put cookies in your web browser to make sure certain functions work properly, to help us get accurate analytics, or to store your preferences. It's all about making your time here as smooth as possible.

We use both session and persistent cookies on our website, along with essential cookies, which help authenticate users and prevent fraudulent use.

Cookie	Name	Purpose
Necessary	JSESSIONID	Necessary to help make our website usable by enabling basic functions like page navigation and access to secure areas of the website. Our website cannot function properly without these cookies.
Preference	lang	Enable us to remember information that changes the website behaves or looks, such as preferred language selection
Statistics	@@History/@@scroll # _ga _gat _gid	Enable us to understand how visitors interact with websites by collecting and reporting information anonymously
